636 AM EST MON DEC 24 2007

FOR WATERS BEYOND FIVE NAUTICAL MILES OF SHORE ON LAKE ERIE

.SYNOPSIS...WEAKENING LOW PRESSURE 29.50 INCHES OVER THE NORTHERN GREAT LAKES WILL MERGE WITH A DEVELOPING LOW SOUTH OF JAMES BAY WHICH WILL THEN MOVE NORTHEAST ACROSS THE CANADIAN MARITIMES. A TROUGH OF LOW PRESSURE 29.80 INCHES WILL MOVE ACROSS LAKE ERIE THIS MORNING. HIGH PRESSURE 30.30 INCHES OVER THE MISSISSIPPI VALLEY WILL MOVE CROSS THE OHIO VALLEY TUESDAY AND OFF THE MID ATLANTIC COAST WEDNESDAY. A WEAK COLD FRONT FROM THE NORTHERN PLAINS WILL MOVE TO NEAR LAKE ERIE AND DISSIPATE BY THURSDAY. ANOTHER COLD FRONT WILL DEVELOPS OVER THE PLAINS STATES AND BEGIN TO MOVE EAST.
