SOUTHWEST GALES AT 35 TO 40 KNOTS WILL DEVELOP ACROSS THE WESTERN  
BASIN OF LAKE ERIE SUNDAY AFTERNOON AND EVENING AS A STRONG COLD  
FRONT SWEEPS THROUGH THE REGION. AS A RESULT...THE WATER LEVEL  
WILL DROP BELOW THE CRITICAL MARK FOR SAFE NAVIGATION LATE THIS  
AFTERNOON AND REMAIN BELOW UNTIL MONDAY MORNING.

AT 5 AM EST...THE WATER LEVEL AT TOLEDO WAS 20 INCHES ABOVE CHART  
DATUM...OR ABOUT 35 INCHES ABOVE THE CRITICAL MARK. AS WINDS  
INCREASE THIS AFTERNOON...THE LEVELS SHOULD REACH THE CRITICAL MARK BY  
LATE SUNDAY AFTERNOON AND EVENTUALLY DROP TO 2 FEET BELOW THE  
CRITICAL MARK SUNDAY NIGHT. LEVELS SHOULD RECOVER ABOVE THE  
CRITICAL MARK BY LATE MONDAY MORNING.

MASTERS PLANNING NAVIGATION INTO THE WESTERN BASIN OF LAKE ERIE  
SUNDAY AFTERNOON THROUGH MONDAY MORNING SHOULD CHECK CURRENT  
WATER LEVELS WITH THE COAST GUARD.
